


- The Parent Insights Survey was conducted in early/mid-March of 2018.
















## At which grade level do you believe subject level specialization should be implemented?




### Do you feel your child has or will benefit from Teacher/Content Specialization?




## What advice would you give the District in terms of continuing to implement the Teacher/Content Specialization strategy?




### Has your child participated in Problem-Based Learning?




### Do you feel your child has or will benefit from Problem-Based Learning?




# What advice would you give in terms of continuing to use the Problem-Based Learning teaching strategy?








### What advice would you give in terms of continuing the FLES program?



### Should foreign language instruction be extended for all 6th grade students?




## Do you believe Hadley Junior High School students would benefit from receiving daily foreign language instruction?




