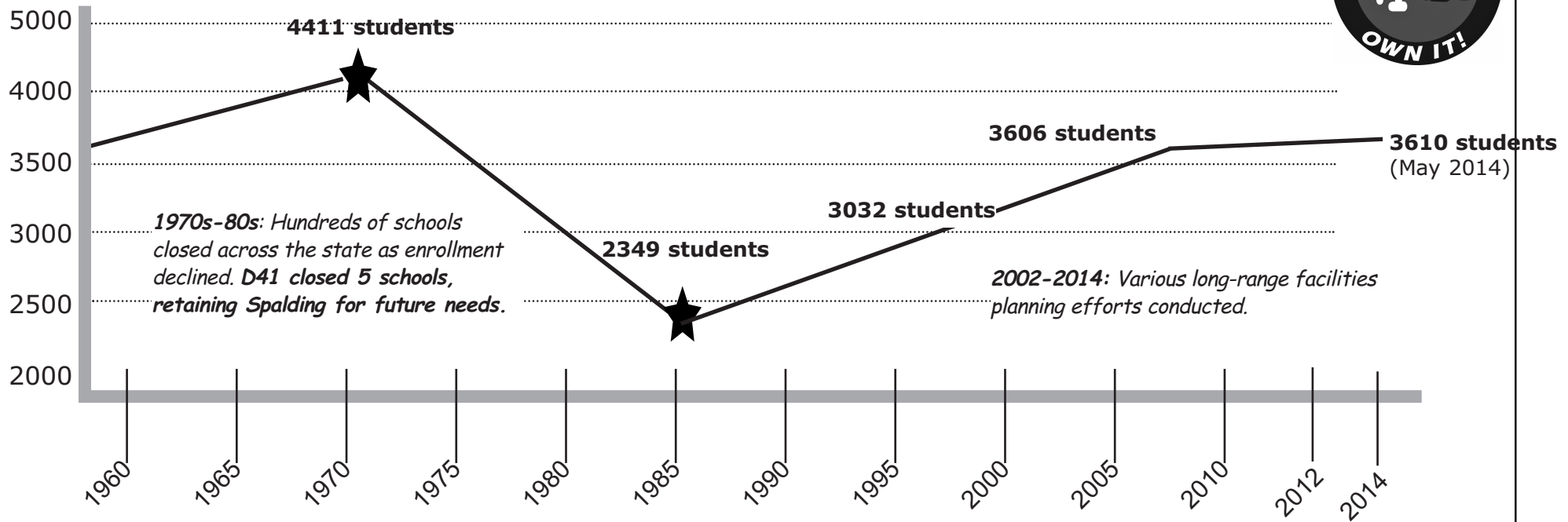


D4I FACILITIES TIMELINE



1970s-80s: Hundreds of schools closed across the state as enrollment declined. D41 closed 5 schools, retaining Spalding for future needs.

2002-2014: Various long-range facilities planning efforts conducted.

1970
Duane St. School sold to village. Additions put on schools.

1971
Central Service Office built.

1978
Glen Oak, Spalding schools closed, leased.

1981
Hawthorne, Main St. schools closed, leased.

1982
Glen Oak sold to Forest Preserve; Main St. sold to Park District.

1994
Rate referendum fails. Hawthorne School sold, demolished.

1997
\$28M facilities referendum funds renovations, additions, technology.

Spalding demolished, land retained.

2001
Rate referendum funds programs, teachers.

2001-2009
32 portables installed across district.

2004
Task Force recommends new building, program changes.

2007
\$40M facilities referendum fails.

2009
Master Facility Plan recommendation.

2010-2011
BOE Finance Committee studies MFP recommendation.

2013-2014
Additions to elementary schools underway; removal of some portables.
Continued facility planning.
