




# Y GUIDES AND Y PRINCESSES PROGRAM Building Strong Kids, Strong Families, Strong Communities

# Y GUIDES AND Y PRINCESSES PROGRAM FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Q: Do we have to be members of the YMCA?

A: No. Y members get a discounted registration fee; however, all events are the same price for both Y members and non-members.

#### Q: How much does the program cost?

A: The program fee is \$30 per child for Y members; each additional child is \$15. For non-members, the fee is \$65 and each additional child is \$20. There is no fee for dads.

The fee for each event is different and is charged upon event registration. You only pay for events you wish to attend. Several events held locally are free. Financial assistance is available for this program through B.R. Ryall YMCA if needed.

#### Q: What do we do after we join?

A: There are several events throughout the year—from September through July. Below is the current schedule of events, with more coming soon:
