



Glen Ellyn Youth Baseball Association Fall Baseball 2009

The Glen Ellyn Youth Baseball Association (GEYBA) will again offer a Fall Baseball season which will run from August 21st, 2009 through October 4th, 2009, with an end of season tournament. No games will be scheduled on Labor Day weekend. The purpose of the Fall Baseball season will be to allow players to enjoy organized baseball in the Fall while they continue to develop their baseball skills.

Registration for Fall Baseball:

Registration can be done *on line* at: www.gepark.org or *in person* at the Spring Avenue Recreation Center, 185 Spring Avenue or the Main Street Recreation Center, 501 Hill Avenue thru June 24th, 2009. Those who do not register by June 24th will be added to the waiting list.

Fees: The Glen Ellyn Park District Resident fee is \$110.00 and the Non-Resident fee is \$165.00 per player which includes uniform, equipment use, fields, umpires and baseballs. Acceptable modes of payment are Visa, MasterCard, Discover or a check made payable to the Glen Ellyn Park District. An Athletic Form and Waiver must be completed and presented with payment.

Evaluations: All players will be randomly assigned to a team. Previous season coaches' and parents' evaluations will be used to assure team parity. Depending on sign up, some teams may be made up of players from Glen Ellyn and Lombard.

*Age eligibility is based on age as of April 30, 2009.

Rules of Play: Rules of play will be determined by GEYBA and the Lombard Baseball league. Pitching, base distances and other rules will be similar to rules that the player will be using during their next spring season.

Time Commitment: The time commitment will involve at least one weekday practice with two weekend games. This may vary depending on weather, make-up games and scheduling issues. A serious commitment of 80-90% participation in practices and games will be expected.
