2018 GRADUATION DETAILS

- Where** Glenbard West High School Biester Gym, 670 Crescent Boulevard, Glen Ellyn, IL 60137
- When** **Friday, June 1, 2018.** The ceremony will begin promptly at 7:00 PM. We ask that all graduates report to the Glenbard West field house between 6:15 and 6:30 PM. There is limited supervision prior to 6:15 so please do not arrive early.
- Seating** Seating is on a first come first serve basis. All guests entering the gymnasium must have a ticket. There is a limited amount of special seating available for handicapped guests. **Please contact the main office at (630) 790-6450 if arrangements need to be made for special needs.** It is important that this request be made no later than May 25 so that we can accommodate you.
- Tickets** **The** capacity of Biester Gym is limited so admission is by ticket only. Every child is eligible for four (4) tickets. Graduation tickets will be given to students on June 1, 2018. Students will be responsible for bringing tickets home. You may pick them up in person if you choose.
- Dress** For the graduation ceremony, students are expected to dress in school appropriate attire and adhere to the school dress code. Please encourage your child to dress nicely and refer to pages 12 in the Hadley student handbook for specific dress code guidelines.
- Diploma** Students who complete the required course of study will receive a diploma. Attendance at the ceremony is not required to receive the diploma. Diplomas will be issued to students after the ceremony in the field house, located in the lower level of the gymnasium. Parents may also choose to pick up the diploma from school on June 4.
- Attendance** Students are required to be in attendance at school on June 1. Failure to be at school on graduation day excludes participation in the graduation ceremony.
- Please inform the office no later than May 25 if your son/daughter will not be attending the graduation ceremony on June 1.**
- Photographer** A professional photographer from *Grad Images* will take photos of students as they receive their diplomas. Proofs will be mailed to your home. Once you receive the proof, you can purchase pictures if desired.
- Behavior** Graduation ceremony is a privilege and may be revoked due to excessive disciplinary referrals or by creating a situation of severe safety, health, or disruption at school.
- Records** At the end of the school year, your child's education records are sent to Glenbard West High School. **If your child will not be attending Glenbard West in the fall, please notify the 8th grade guidance counselor, Mrs. Sharon Dunham at sdunham@d41.org or Holly Stropes at hstropes@d41.org as soon as possible.
