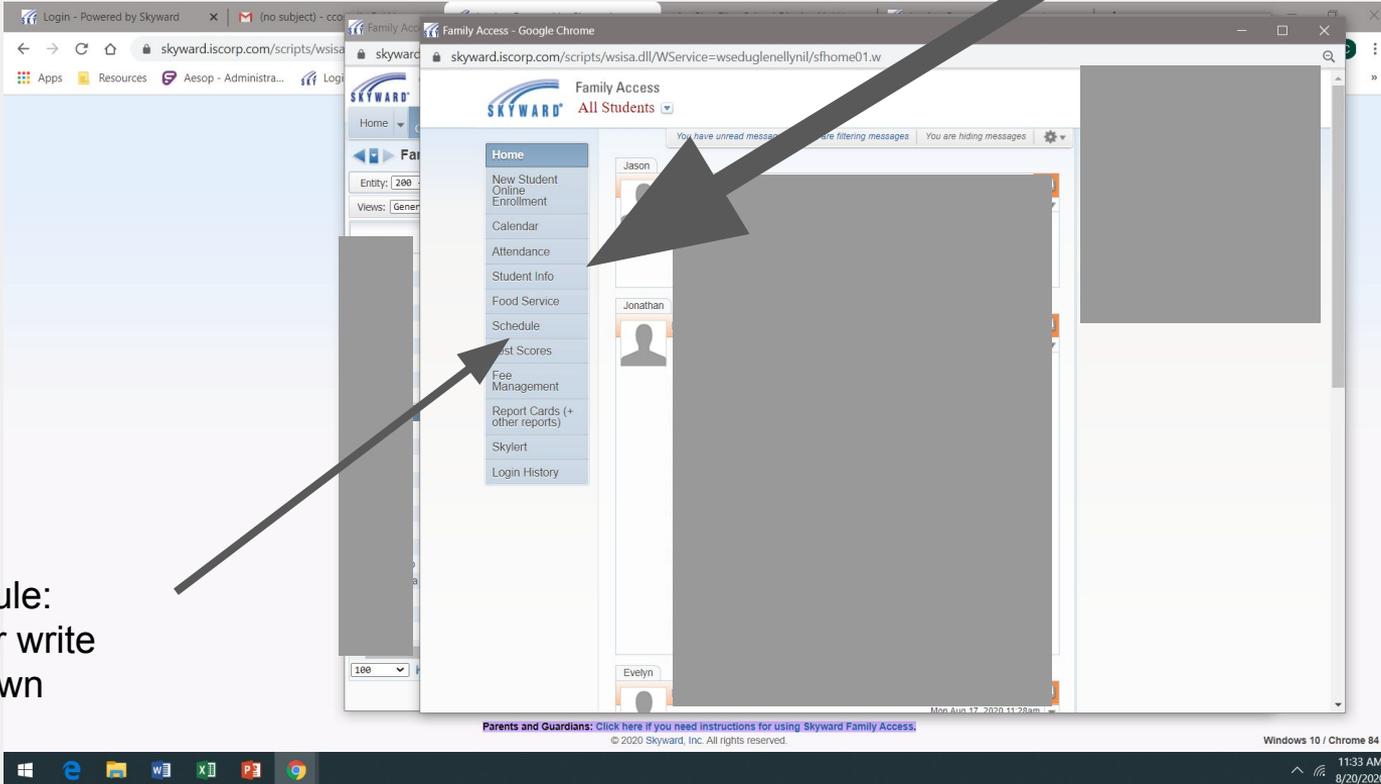

Parents can view the student account info in Skyward Family Access. Here's how:

1. In Skyward Family Access, click the *Student Info* button in the menu on the left.
2. Next to their child's picture, the "School:" field has the student's Google account username.
3. Under the child's picture the "Other ID:" field has the student ID number, which is also their Google password.

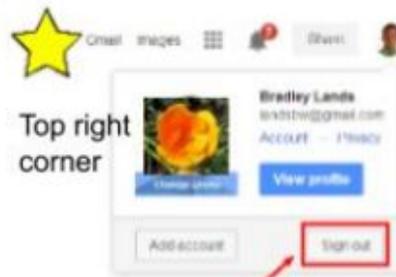
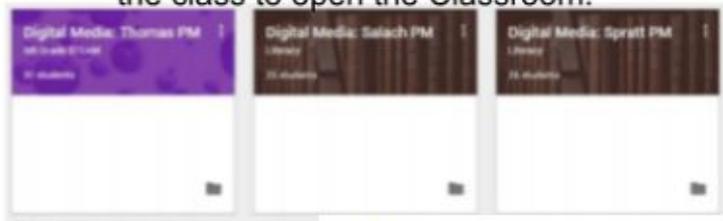


## Enter the username and password

the class to open the Classroom.



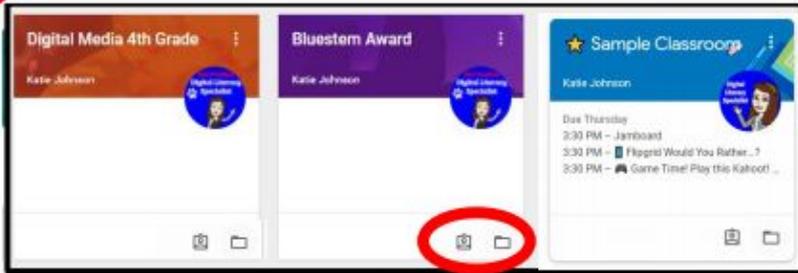

If your child is signed into Google he/she can also get to Google Apps, including Google Classroom, Google Drive, and Gmail by clicking the Apps Grid (9 dots). You will find this at the top right corner next to the profile icon.

Don't forget to sign out of  
your child's account.

In the upper left corner click the three lines for the Main Menu.

These are your Class icons. To enter a class simply click on the class name (white text). The  icon will show you your work. The  icon will bring you to your Google Drive.

In the upper right corner.

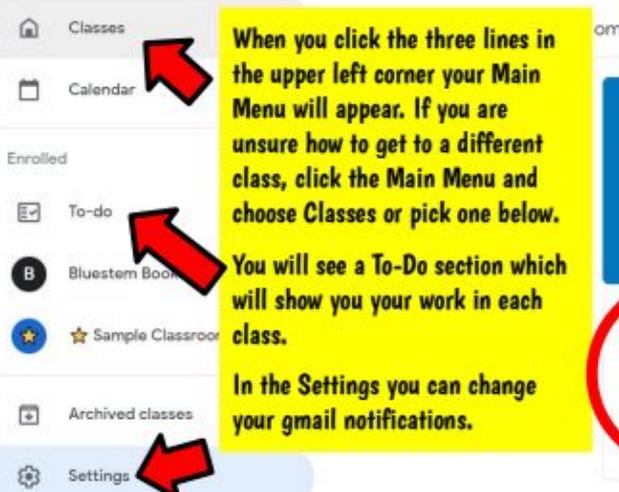


The + sign allows you to join a class by a code.

The 9 dot grid will show your other Google Apps. It's a quick way to get to other apps like Gmail.

The circle profile shows who is logged into Classroom. Your D41 school profile should be in the upper right corner. If not, switch accounts to be able to view your classes.

Step 7 (for students) :  
Open up Google Classroom to View Classes.



When you click the three lines in the upper left corner your Main Menu will appear. If you are unsure how to get to a different class, click the Main Menu and choose Classes or pick one below.

You will see a To-Do section which will show you your work in each class.

In the Settings you can change your gmail notifications.

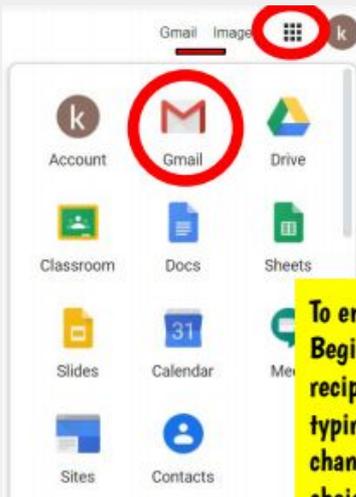


When you open a class you will see Stream, Classwork and People at the top.

Stream will show you announcements.  
Classwork will show you your assignments, announcements and materials.

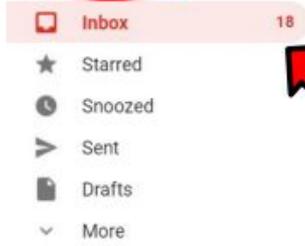
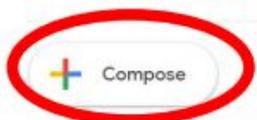
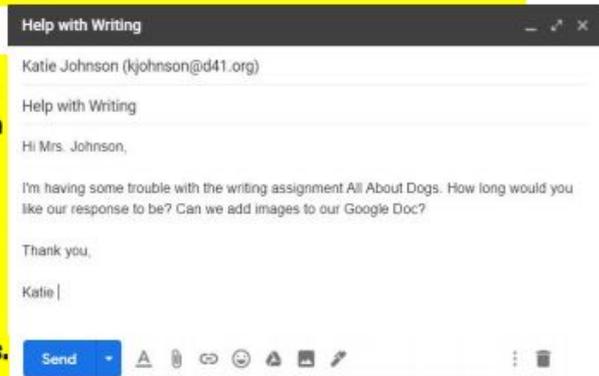
People will show you participants in the class and from there you can also click to email your teacher which will open up gmail.

You will see Upcoming on the left side showing work that is due.

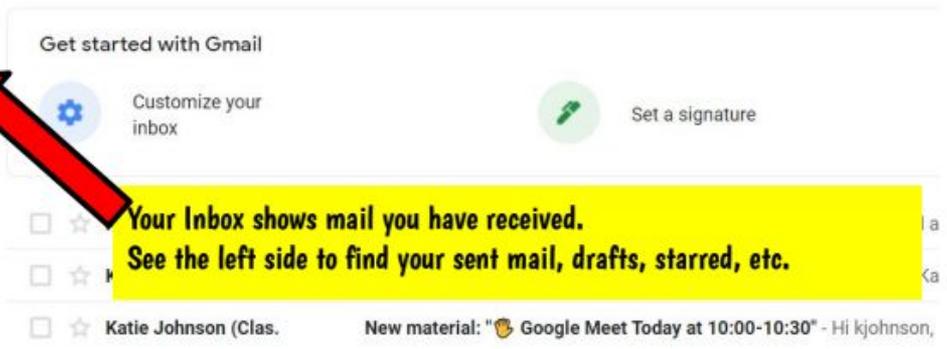


When you sign into your Chromebook with your school account you can click on Chrome (colorful circle) and then find the Google Apps Grid (9 dots in upper right corner). There you will see all your Apps. On a Chromebook you will also see them on the Apps Launcher or if you have pinned some of the apps they will be on the Chromebook shelf.

To email a teacher click on the + Compose. Begin typing your teacher's email address in recipient box. Add a subject then begin typing your email. You can attach a file or change the font settings with the menu choices at the bottom. When finished click Send at the bottom. If you just close it without hitting Send it will be in your drafts.

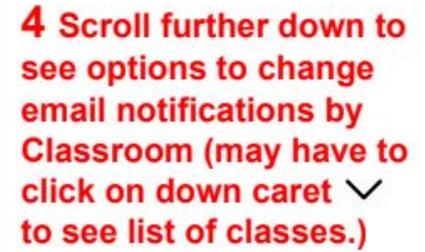
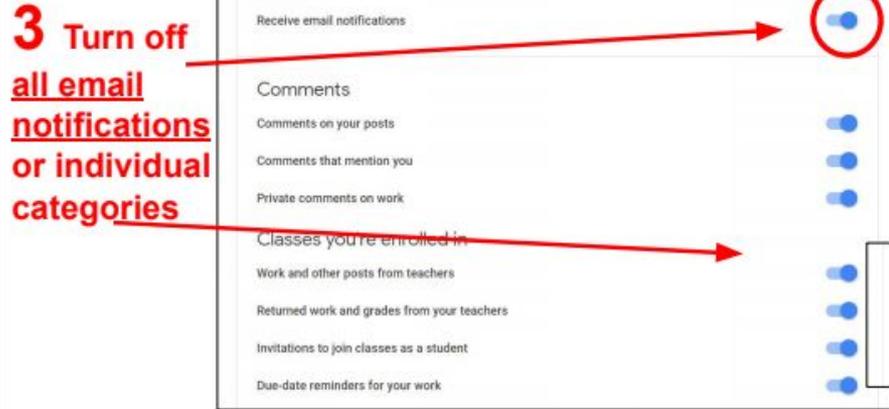
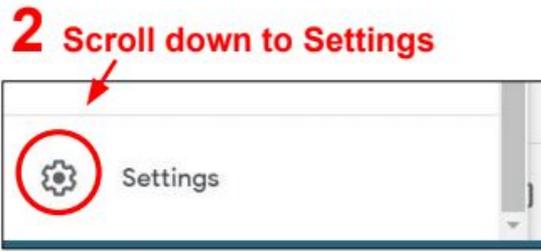
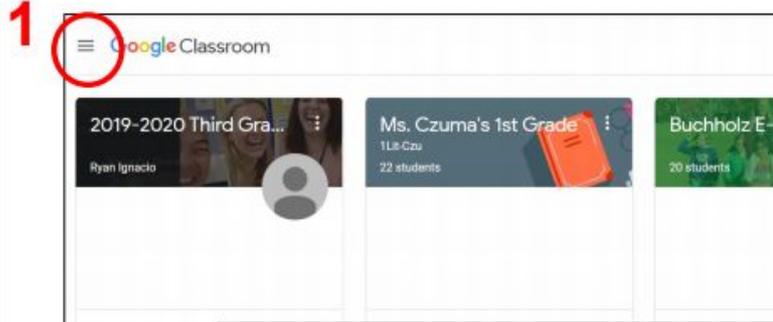


Your Inbox shows mail you have received. See the left side to find your sent mail, drafts, starred, etc.

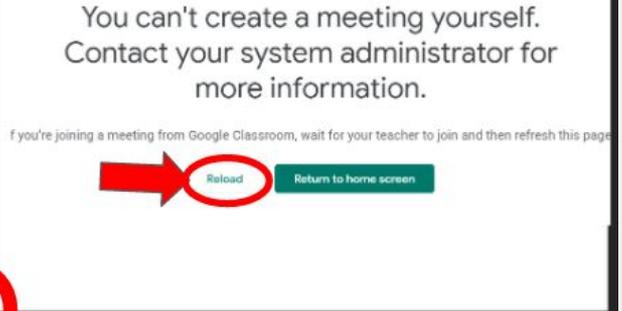
# Google Meet

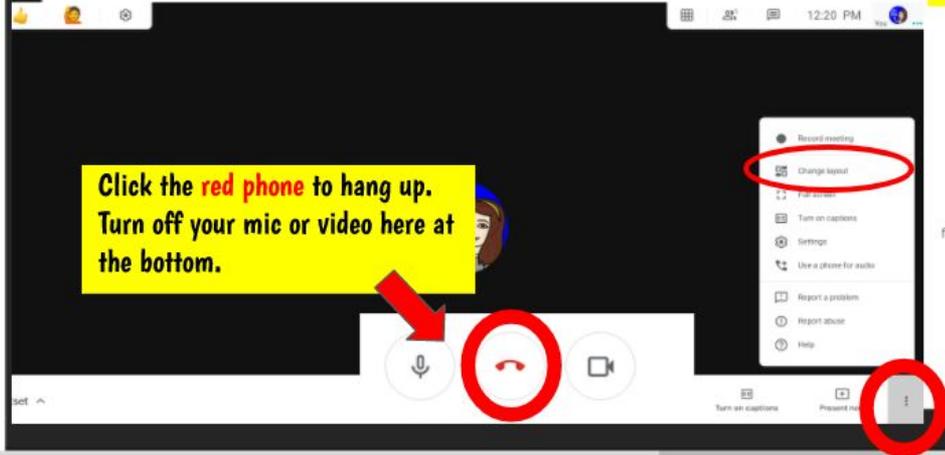
If you see this do not click return to home screen, but go back to Classroom to click the link again. If you see this message below, just click reload or refresh your page.

# A Tech Guide for D41 Families

Welcome, families, to a new school year! Do you have questions about the technology in remote learning? Use this guide as a helpful resource.

## For parents and caregivers:

**Q: How will I get information about announcements, assignments, and other classroom news?**

**A:** *Google Classroom is the main platform all students will be using. You can sign into your child's school Google account if you want to view their Classroom or Gmail. Please sign out when finished viewing.*

**Q: How/where should my child keep track of their assignments?**

**A:** *Google Classroom includes "Classwork" where your child can view work that the teachers assign. If there is a due date attached to the assignment, then your child will see those due dates. Your child can also set Classroom notifications for emails from Google Classroom.*

**Q: How can I contact teachers? How can my child contact teachers?**



**A:** *Teachers all have D41 email addresses that both you and your child can use to contact the teachers. You can find email addresses on the staff directories on each school's website. Students can find the Gmail app by signing into their school account.*

**Q: What should we do if we have technical difficulties or our device breaks?**

**A:** *If you are having technical issues, such as connecting to the internet, contact the district Tech Help Desk (<https://www.d41.org/techathome>). If you have instructional issues, such as accessing your student's Google Classroom, contact your school's Digital Literacy Specialist.*

## For students:



**Q: How will I access remote learning classes?**

**A:** Google Classroom is the main platform to access your announcements, assignments and materials. You can find the Classroom app by signing into your school account and going to the 9 dot Google apps grid in the upper right corner. You can also open a new tab and type [classroom.google.com](https://classroom.google.com). We recommend using the D41 issued Chromebook.

**Q: What should I do if I have remote learning technical difficulties?**

**A:** If you are having trouble accessing or viewing an assignment your teacher posted in Google Classroom, start with contacting your teacher through Gmail, a private comment in Classroom, or in a teacher scheduled Google Meet. You can also contact your Digital Media teacher (Digital Literacy Specialist) the same way by emailing, commenting in your Digital Media Google Classroom or asking questions in your scheduled Digital Media Google Meet class. If there is something wrong with your Chromebook or Internet, have your family use the Tech Help Desk <https://www.d41.org/techathome>.

**Q: How should I keep track of my assignments?**

**A:** In each Google Classroom you will have a "Stream" that will show announcements and "Classwork" that will show your assignments. There is a "View Your Work" button on the Classwork page to see what is due. Google Classroom will be organized by date, so you can see what is expected for each day.
