Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund

- To date there have been three rounds of funding under the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Grant (ESSER)
- These are one-time allocations related to the COVID-19 pandemic that can cover expenses dating back to March 13, 2020
- The Grants are reimbursement grants. Expenses are completed and then we submit for reimbursement

ESSER Background

- ESSER I: D41 was allocated \$282,967.
- ESSER I has been fully spent and the District has been reimbursed. Funds were used to pay for online curriculum resources for remote learning, personal protective equipment (PPE), specialized cleaning supplies, Chromebooks and a small amount of purchased mental health services.

ESSER Background (Cont.)

- ESSER II: D41 was allocated \$1,108,017
- ESSER II has been fully spent and the District has been reimbursed.

Funds were used to pay for furniture, COVID-19 testing, PPE, specialized cleaning supplies and cold food storage to accommodate modified meal distributions.

ESSER III

- ESSER III: D41 was allocated \$2,490,806
- We have submitted our application for ESSER III but have not yet requested any reimbursements. We plan to submit for reimbursement in the coming weeks.
