

Glen Ellyn School District 41 2012-13 Benchmarking Study




Only about 1 percent of schools will likely meet that 92.5 percent passing standard, the lowest performance ever, according to a review by Advantage Analytics LLC, a consulting company that crunches data for Butler and other school districts.





State's "Meet and Exceed" Criteria





Methodology

The source data used by Advantage Analytics is publicly available and includes results on the Illinois Student Achievement Test (ISAT) and financial information provided to the state by school districts. While the state provides comparisons on ISAT results, the way it does so makes it difficult to know how students are really doing. The "cut scores" the state uses to categorize Meets, Exceeds, and so forth vary by subject and change from grade-to-grade and from year-to-year. Advantage Analytics "normalizes" the data by creating an index score that overcomes distortions that are inherent in the way the state reports ISAT scores to provide a true comparative picture of their performance.

- Normalize data for the purpose of achieving comparability.
- State Average =100 for all:
 - Grades
 - **Subjects**
 - Years
- This is the same process as was used in District 41's 2011 study.





Fit Comparison for 3rd Reading




Upper 9.6% of State's 3rd







Fit Comparison for 5th Grade Reading









Fit Comparison for 6th Grade Reading





Fit Comparison for 3rd Grade Mathematics














































Property Tax as proportion of revenue




Revenue per student below benchmark average






Expenses per student below benchmark average






Budget surplus among benchmark districts




2012-2013 performance changes





> **Annual Improvement Rate**




Overall cohort trend
