
Do you feel your students have or will benefit from Teacher/Content Specialization?














Foreign language is currently offered to all 7th and 8th grade students.

Do you feel it is important to maintain daily foreign language instruction in grades 6, 7 and 8?













- Parents support full-day Kindergarten, but expressed concerns about a tuition and the lottery system.
- Parents expressed support for PBLs, specialization and FLES.
