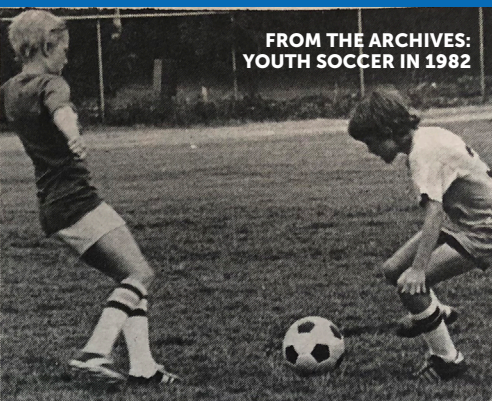

About the Program **AF**

Grade: Pre-K to 10

House league soccer is a Glen Ellyn Park District program run with the assistance of Glen Ellyn Youth Soccer Organization (GEYSO). The program teaches soccer skills while promoting good sportsmanship, physical conditioning and having fun. There are nine age levels for boys and girls. PRACTICES: Start the week of April 1, 2019

GAMES: Saturdays from April 13, 2019 to June 1, 2019

Games are played at Ackerman Park on Saturdays between the hours of approximately 8A and 2P. Practices are held once a week for one hour according to the volunteer coach's schedule. Practice locations are also dependent on coach's availability. All practices are held within Glen Ellyn. Pre-K soccer will play on Saturdays only, with teams practicing prior to game kick-off.

TEAM NOTIFICATION: Parents will be notified of their child's team beginning March 26, 2019. Please contact us if you have not heard from a coach by March 31, 2019.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How does the Buddy System work?

With the numerous requests we receive each season, we have adopted a BUDDY SYSTEM to help organize the teams.

How it works:

- 1) There is a field on the registration form where you can enter the name of your requested Buddy. You may only request one (1) Buddy.
- 2) If the person you have requested as a Buddy also requests you as a Buddy, we will make sure to place both on the same team. Unless both players request each other there is no guarantee you will be placed on the same team.
- 3) As always, siblings playing in the same age group will automatically be placed on the same team unless there is a request to separate them.

No other requests for teammates or specific coaches will be accepted. Teams will still be organized as much as possible by geographic area/school, dependent on the number of coaches available from each area.

Should I register my daughter for Girls or Co-Rec?

Co-Rec teams usually consist of 1-2 girls per team with the majority of the roster being made up of boys. Girls teams will be made up of only girls and they will only play other all girls teams.

What equipment does my child need?

Players must bring their own ball to practice. Shin guards must be worn under socks and all eyewear must be protective. Kids will be provided a t-shirt (pre-K to 2nd) and jersey/shorts (3rd to 10th) for their uniforms.



Interested in Coaching?

In accordance with the GEYSO policy, teams will be reorganized each season. The child of a coach is assigned to the team the parent is coaching. Individuals volunteering to serve as head coaches ONLY, may request one (1) assistant coach whose child will be assigned to that team. Volunteers will be notified by telephone if they are needed as coaches.

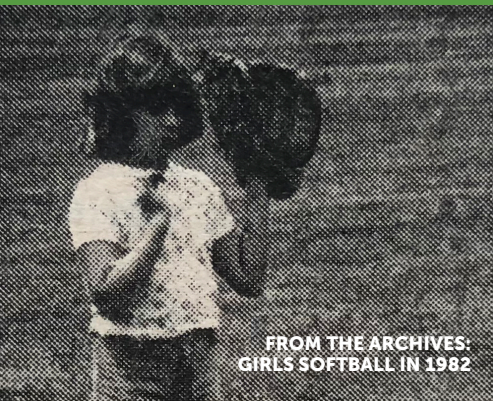

ABOUT THE PROGRAM **AF**

Girls Softball is a Glen Ellyn Park District program run with the assistance of the Glen Ellyn Girls Softball Association. The program teaches girls softball skills, while promoting teamwork, skill development, game rules, good sportsmanship, and fun.

GRADES PRE-K TO 8: Our softball program gives girls a chance to play and have fun while learning softball skills, teamwork, game rules, and sportsmanship. The program begins with T-Ball for Kindergartners and goes up through high school. Playoffs and All Star games are held for 3rd grade league and up. Leagues are recreational at the younger ages and become progressively more competitive through part-time and full-time travel leagues. We strive to provide development and options to keep it fun as our players grow older and play to their level of competition.

The spring program is the House League. Teams typically play two games per week (one weeknight/one Saturday) at Ackerman Park. Teams are formed in mid-March and practices begin in April. The season runs through the end of June. Team shirts and protective equipment are provided by age group. Girls must supply their own gloves and may use their own bats and helmets. We strongly encourage parent participation as volunteers in various areas. The House League program is solely dependent on volunteer coaches and assistants. The Glen Ellyn Girls Softball Association offers support through league commissioners, coaches’ clinics, and training materials. (cb)

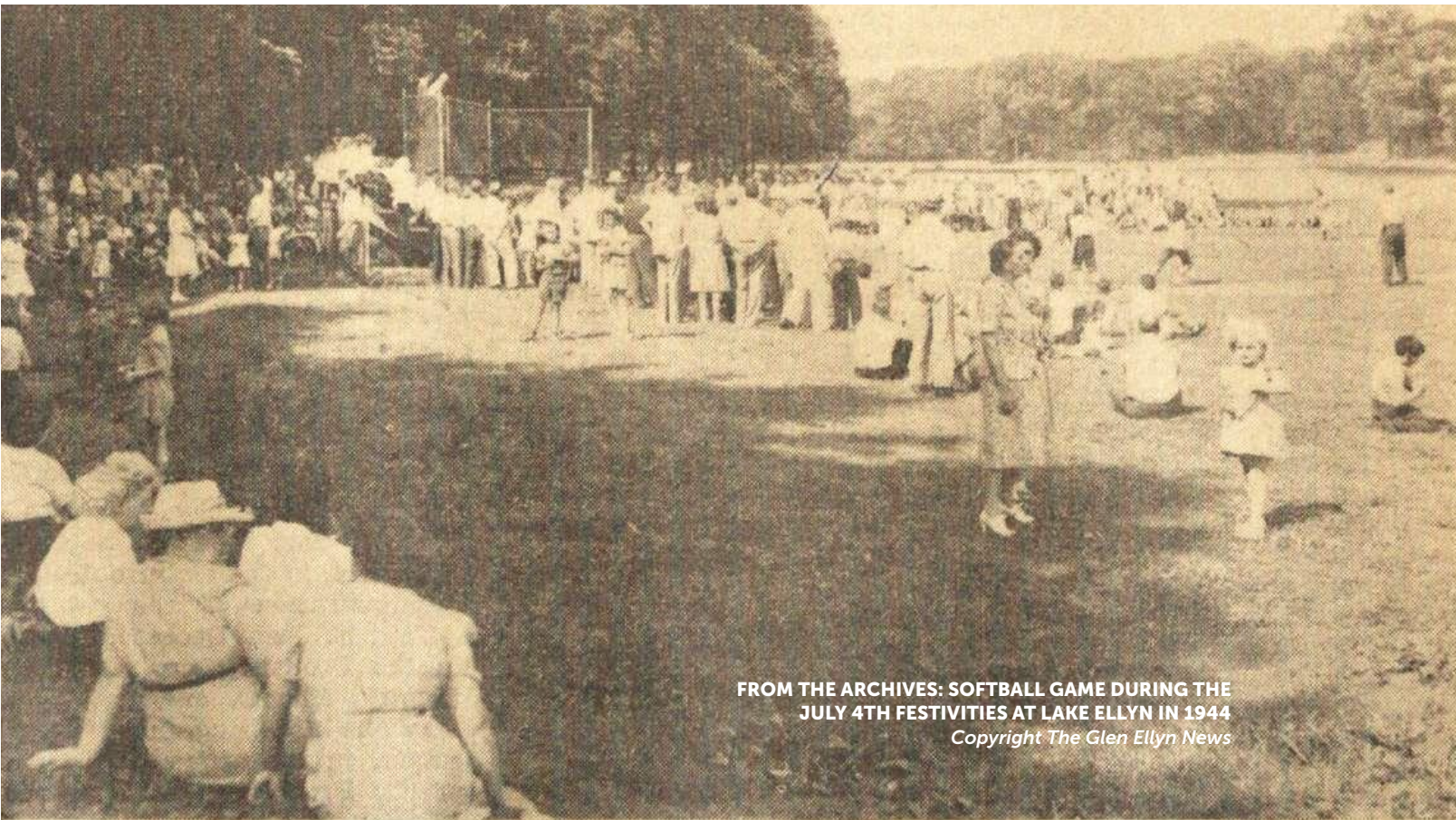

ABOUT THE PROGRAM **AF**

Youth Baseball is a Glen Ellyn Park District program run with the assistance of the Glen Ellyn Youth Baseball Association (GEYBA), a volunteer organization that strives to develop skills while promoting teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline, citizenship and well-being. Parent participation is the heart of Glen Ellyn baseball. All GEYBA committee members and coaches are volunteers.

Teams are formed in early March and Practices begin in April.
The season runs through the end of June. (cb)

League Description

T-BALL 1 (Pre-K to Ages 4-5)

Kids learn to hit the ball off a tee. There is no catcher and everyone bats and plays the field. Teams are divided up by schools.

T-BALL 2 (Kindergarten)

Kids hit off a tee but by the end of the year, a coach may pitch the ball from a few feet away. There is no catcher, and everyone plays the field and bats. Teams are divided up by schools.

BANTAM (1st Grade)

Pitching machines are used the entire season, there is no catcher, and everyone plays the field and bats. Teams are divided up by schools.

SHETLAND (2nd Grade)

A combination of kids/machine pitch. Ten players are allowed on the field including a catcher. Teams are divided up by multiple schools.

MAVERICK (3rd Grade) STALLION (4th Grade)

Players are drafted by ability based on a player evaluation. A post-season tournament determines a league champion for both. Teams are formed with no relation to schools, utilizing a full draft.

MUSTANG (5th/6th Grade) PONY (7th/8th Grade)

Age groups are combined and players are drafted by ability based on a player evaluation. A post-season tournament determines a league champion.

CHEERLEADING

Golden Eagles Football and Competitive Cheerleading

Grade: 2-8 (as of 8/31/19)

This two-fold program for girls and boys includes sideline cheering and halftime routines at the Golden Eagles Tackle and Flag Football games as well as participation in cheer competitions in the Chicagoland area. We teach technical cheer fundamentals along with short dance and cheer routines. Cheerleaders learn skills including stunting, tumbling, and a variety of jumps. Each squad cheers weekly during football season and competes in Illinois Recreational Cheer Association (IRCA) sanctioned competitions. While no prior experience is necessary, it is helpful to have dance or gymnastics skills. However, nothing can replace a good attitude, a sparkling smile and a commitment to your teammates. (ch)

PROGRAM RUNS: July-Early December

SQUAD FORMATION: Squads are determined in June. Grade levels may be combined.

PRACTICE: Begins in early July and are multiple days a week until school starts. After school begins, practices are held two nights per week for the remainder of the season.

COMMITMENT: Cheer is the ultimate team sport that does not allow for substitutions of positions, and routines are choreographed early in the season to include all athletes at all times. As such, attendance at practice is vital and fully expected. For the safety of the athletes, missed practices may result in the athlete not being able to fully participate in half time performances and/or competitions.

SCHEDULES: Competition schedules will be released in late June. Football schedules will be released at the end of August and squads will begin cheering for games after Labor Day.

VOLUNTEERS: As the program relies heavily on volunteers to be successful, parental involvement is necessary. If interested, please indicate at time of registration so you can take advantage of coach training offered early in the year.

FUNDRAISING: The Golden Eagles Cheerleading program will complete fundraisers during the season with a mandatory \$200 commitment per athlete. These funds will cover professional choreography and music mixing for each squad as well as team stipend for competitions.

FEE COVERS: Uniform, competition fees, and practice spaces. A payment plan is available.

CANCELLATIONS: A \$125 fee will be charged for cancellations after April 30. No refunds will be issued effective June 1.

The tackle program participates in the Bill George Youth Football League (www.bgyfl.org).

Players learn and develop the fundamentals of tackle football, teamwork, sportsmanship and leadership in a supervised, organized and safe environment.

This is a travel league that plays teams from surrounding suburbs. The tackle program begins the last week of July/first week of August and ends in early November. Teams practice daily in August and three days a week when school starts through the end of the season. Games are played on weekends at Newton Park and in surrounding communities.

There are multiple scrimmage games prior to the season, including the annual Golden Eagle Football Jamboree held in mid-August to kick-off the season and raise funds to support the program.
