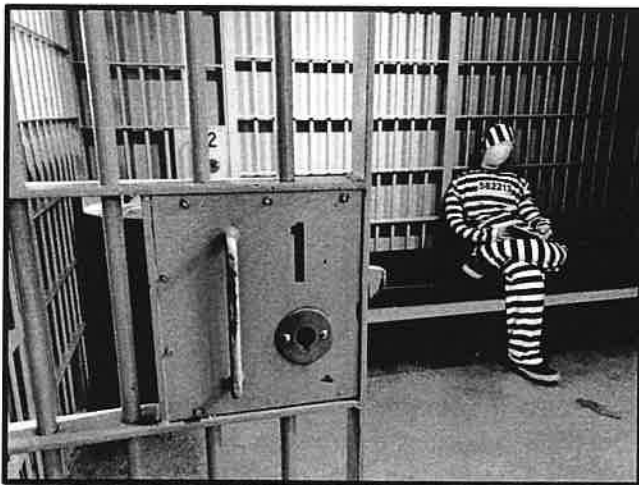
The Civic Center Jail Lives On!
