A Prescription for Healthy Habitats



t may seem to go against common sense, but sometimes fire can be a good thing.

Prescription burns

- Turn dried plants into ash, which allows nutrients inside to mix in with the soil more quickly.
- Knock back newly sprouted invasive and unwanted brush.
- Create large open areas of black soil and ash that absorb more heat from the sun, speeding up the growth of native plants.

Vocabulary of a Prescription Burn

Prescription

Plan developed by Forest Preserve District natural resource managers that dictates which units to burn and when

Burn unit

Area being burned (There are several here at Fullersburg Woods Forest Preserve.)



Burn boss

Decides the morning of a burn if it's OK to proceed, directs the crew and communicates with fire departments



Line tender

Puts fires out along the firebreak

Burn crew

Employees trained on how to work together safely during a prescription burn

Crew leader

Determines the pace of lighting the fire and directs torch operators and line tenders



Torch operator

Lights the fire along the edge of the burn unit and the interior if needed



Firebreak

Low vegetation at the edge of a burn unit that keeps the fire from spreading
