School Physicals and Medical Requirements

Prior to the first day of school, please ensure that all of the medical requirements are fulfilled with the school nurse's office. Glen Ellyn School District 41 [policy](#) requires a child entering kindergarten, 6th grade or new to District 41 have a current State of Illinois physical and updated immunization record on file prior to the first day of the school year. Meal Options and Free/Reduced-Price Eligibility

Children in grades 1-8 may purchase lunch each day at a regular price or breakfast (Churchill School and Hadley only) for grades Kindergarten through 8. Each student will have a meal account where funds are deposited by

parents either using the online system in [Skyward Family Access](#) or if you do not use the online option, please send a check to the school office.

A notification is provided at the beginning of each school year as federally required regarding eligibility requirements and the application process for the free and reduced-price food services that are listed in Board policy 4:130. Also, District 41 will work to prevent meal charges from accumulating. Efforts to collect funds due to the District will be made on a regular basis and before the end of the school year.
