2020-2021 Live stream lessons due to COVID Pandemic MOU-CONFIDENTIAL BARGAINING

The Board of Education (the "Board") of Glen Ellyn School District No. 41 (the "School District") and the Glen Ellyn Education Association, IEA/NEA (the "Association") agree as follows with respect to modification of the 2020-2022 Teachers' Agreement, regarding teachers live streaming lessons for remote students and teachers on quarantine livestream into classroom:

In some instances staff will live stream in person lessons for remote students where there are only a few students in the remote section and need specialized instruction. In order to live stream lessons the district will provide technology such as a headset, conference microphone, speakers (if needed) and a document camera. Hadley staff that are live streaming a lesson will have another staff member to assist with the technology due to the short time period and to ensure the live stream is working while the teacher is teaching.

If a staff member is under required quarantine at home due to a COVID exposure but is otherwise able to work in person, the quarantined teacher will be live streamed into the classroom to continue instruction for the students while another staff or a substitute will supervise the students. The quarantined teacher will be projected on the smart board or computer with Google Meets. The quarantined teacher will not be charged sick leave for the time the teacher is teaching remotely under this MOU.

This memorandum of understanding is not precedential and shall be deemed dated and become effective when the last of the parties signs as set forth below and shall continue in effect until the District returns to full-time, in-person learning for substantially all students or the close of the 2020-2021 school term, whichever is first to occur.
