Assistant Superintendent for Teaching, Learning and Accountability Dr. Katie McCluskey presented data from the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA / MAP assessment data). She shared the norms and explained how to interpret the data. The data included proficiency and college readiness, longitudinal three-year growth, achievement status, and growth by quartile and decile (are students growing equally?). Many celebrations were presented in the data including high growth and high achievement at all of the five District 41 schools. No schools had low achievement and low growth.

In addition to the NWEA report, Dr. McCluskey presented data collected specifically by District 41. Director of Language Programs Theresa Ulrich also presented data for students in the Dual Language Program by grade level. Board members asked questions and discussed the data overall in more detail.
