Make Gmail your default email client in Chrome - you'll want to be able to click on an email link and have Chrome open a gmail window with the address filled in. Here's how:

 Paste this into the address bar of Gmail when you are logged in to Gmail: javascript:navigator.registerProtocolHandler("mailto","https://mail.google.com/mail/?extsrc=mailt o&url=%s","Gmail")

(You may have to manually add the beginning javascript: again because chrome strips it out.)

- 2. Press Enter.
- 3. You will see the first time dialogue box of "do you want to use Gmail as default". Click Yes.

To make this work from Internet Explorer also, you'll need to make Chrome your default web browser. Here's how:

- 1. Click on the Chrome settings icon in the upper right hand corner of the Chrome window.
- 2. Select Settings.
- 3. Under the "Default Browser" heading, click this button.
